What to report

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Flooding ⇒ Water that covers roads or threatens property	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• High Winds (estimate in 10 mph increments)<ul style="list-style-type: none">⇒ 40 mph—Small trees sway⇒ 50 mph—Large trees sway⇒ 60 mph—Smaller tree branches break (up to 1" diameter)⇒ 70 mph—Large tree branches break (1"- 3" diameter)⇒ 80 mph—Tree uprooted⇒ 100 mph—Large tree trunks snapped	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Blowing Dust ⇒ Reduced visibilities to one-half mile or less	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hail (any size) ⇒ Measure the diameter of the LARGEST hail stone with a ruler	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tornado ⇒ Swirling dust on the ground below a funnel cloud
